Sunday Gospel of Jesus Christ Celebration Service

A platform for Pastors to give visibility to this issue. Pastors design the service and preach/teach on Homosexuality. New Hearts Outreach provides brief testimonies of change, altar ministry team, resource table, and 4-6 week follow up church training. Our experience has shown that those attending this service are given permission to come forward for help, whether loved one or overcomer.
